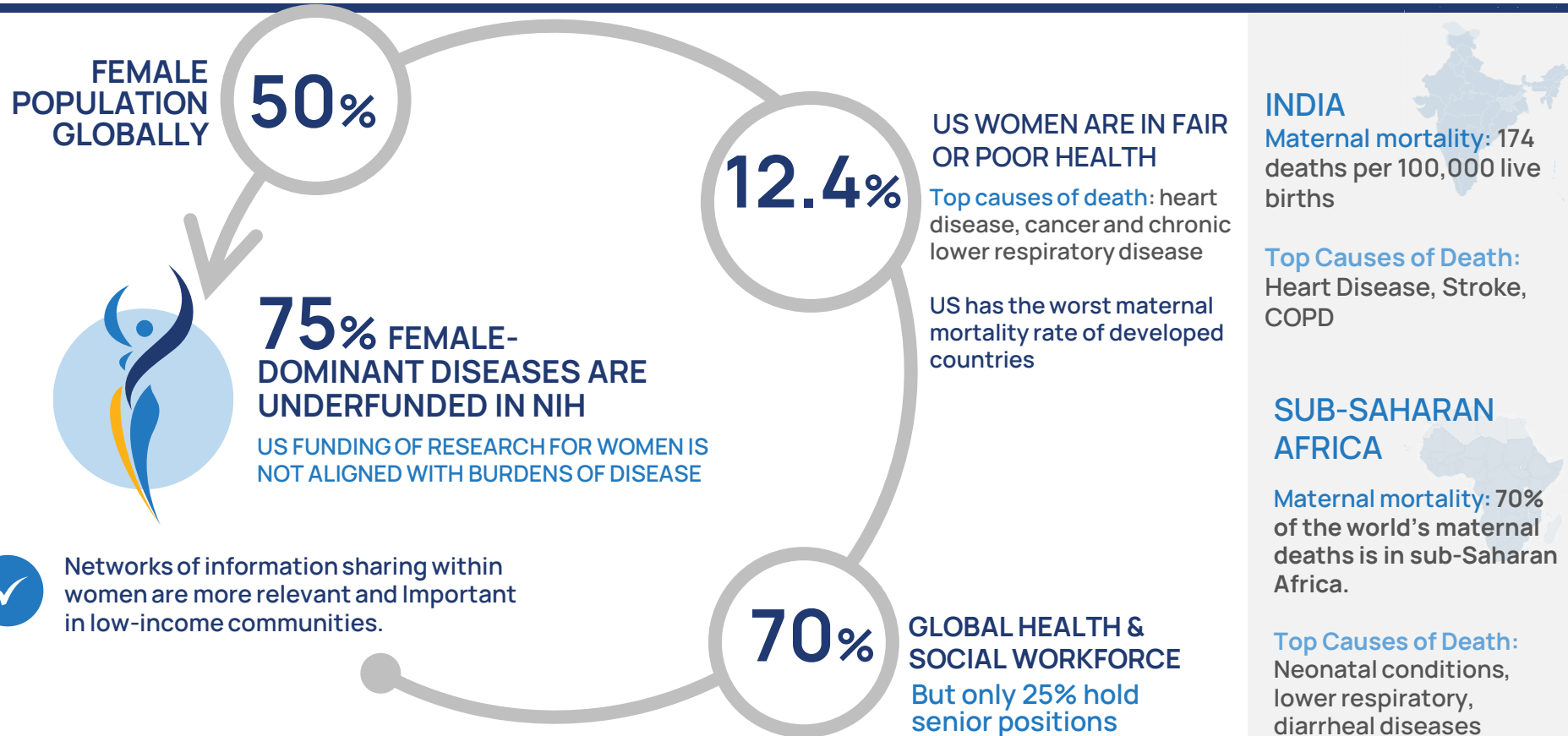

PROVIDERS: Researchers | Clinicians | Pharma

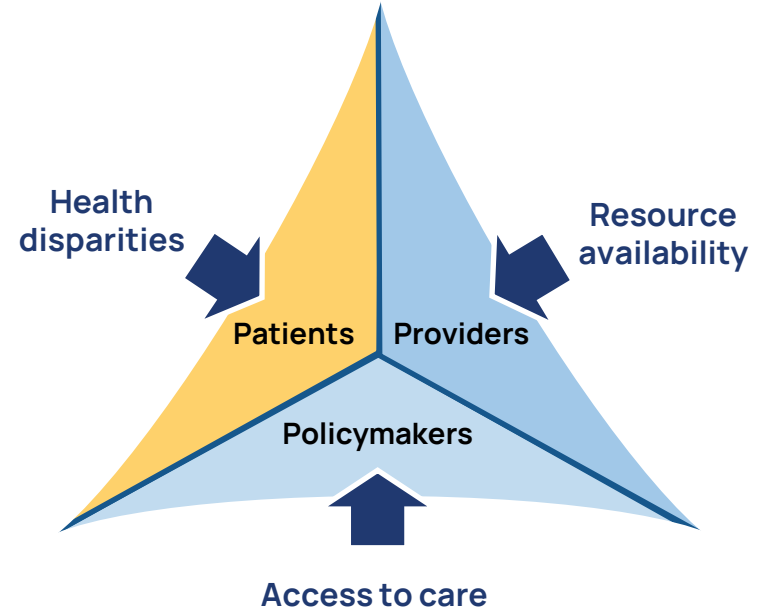
- Investigate knowledge gaps
