ECHAlliance is a Community Interest Company, that means ECHAlliance revenues and activities are used to provide a benefit to communities.





BRAINTEASER is a data science project that seeks to exploit the value of big data, including those related to health, lifestyle habits and environment, to support patients with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis and multiple sclerosis and their clinicians.

Taking advantage of cost-efficient sensors and apps, BRAINTEASER will integrate large, clinical datasets that host both patient-generated and environmental data.





Society needs to scale up a collective capability to learn at scale from health data, to improve health care and to accelerate research. Despite increasing volumes of health data being collected in digital form there are many barriers to widening the uses of it.

In 2020 the Digital Health Society (DHS) partnered with the European Institute for Innovation through Health Data (I~HD) to create a series of multi-stakeholder Round Tables to examine these challenges and opportunities of health data, and to propose practical approaches and Calls to Action that could grow and accelerate health data use.




